

Traffic Flow Eased as Mavis Road Ramp Opens Today

TORONTO, August 29, 2002 – Motorists now have access to Mavis Road when travelling eastbound on 407 ETR, Brampton West-Mississauga MPP and Ontario Health and Long-Term Care Minister Tony Clement, and 407 ETR announced today.

“The opening of the exit ramp to Mavis Road provides greater access to the surrounding communities which will benefit the local economy and help to reduce traffic volume on surrounding routes,” said Minister Clement.

The opening of this exit ramp is expected to help alleviate traffic congestion in the immediate area as many commuter and business drivers will no longer need to travel out of their way to exit Highway 407 and double-back to their intended destination. The eastbound exit ramp ends at a set of traffic lights where travellers can choose to go northbound or southbound on Mavis Road.

“The opening of this exit ramp is good news for our customers,” said Dale Albers, Manager, Public Relations for 407 ETR. “Many customers have been requesting for months that an eastbound exit ramp from 407 ETR to Mavis Road be constructed. Our investment to construct this ramp is further evidence of our commitment to meeting the needs of our customers.”

407 International Inc. is the sole shareholder, operator and manager of 407 ETR, which extends 108 kilometres east-west, just north of Toronto. 407 International Inc. is owned by a consortium comprised of Spanish company Cintra Concesiones de Infraestructuras de Transporte (co-owned by Grupo Ferrovial and Australian headquartered Macquarie Infrastructure Group), SNC-Lavalin Inc., a Canadian engineering and construction company and Macquarie Infrastructure Group, an international owner and developer of toll roads.
