**MACQUARIE INFRASTRUCTURE GROUP
407ETR, M1, M4 AND M5 TRAFFIC
NOVEMBER 2002**

Macquarie Infrastructure Group (MIG), today announced details of traffic use for the 407ETR toll road in Toronto and the Eastern Distributor (M1), M4 and M5 toll roads in Sydney. Due to restrictions imposed by a number of legal agreements dealing with the 407ETR, only monthly statistics on Average Workday Traffic and Total Vehicle Kilometres Travelled can be released. More detailed statistics on the 407ETR are released quarterly.

MIG currently owns:

- Both directly and indirectly (through its holding in Spanish company, Cintra) 43.0% of the equity in 407 International Inc, the owner of the concession for the 407ETR toll road in Toronto;
- 71.35% of the equity in the Airport Motorway Group, the owner of the concession for the Eastern Distributor (M1) in Sydney;
- 50.6% of Statewide Roads Limited, the owner of the concession for the M4 toll road in Sydney; and
- 50% of Interlink Roads Pty Limited, the owner of the concession for the M5 toll road in Sydney.

Total Vehicle Kilometres Travelled on the 407ETR during November 2002 was 1.6% lower than November 2001 and 9.2% lower than October 2002.

The average number of workday trips on the 407ETR during November 2002 was 1.4% higher than November 2001 and 2.9% lower than October 2002.

Average daily toll revenue (net of GST) for Airport Motorway in November 2002 was \$131,344 – a 26.1% increase relative to November 2001.

Average daily tolled traffic on the Eastern Distributor (M1) for November 2002 was 25.2% higher than November 2001 and 4.5% higher than October 2002.

Average weekday traffic on the Eastern Distributor (M1) for November 2002 was 25.8% higher than November 2001.

Average traffic on weekends and public holidays on the Eastern Distributor (M1) for November 2002 was 29.0% higher than November 2001.

Non-cash transactions on the Eastern Distributor (M1) consisted of 38% of average daily traffic in November 2002 (October 2002: 38%).

Interlink Roads - M5

Average daily toll revenue (net of GST) for Interlink Roads in November 2002 was \$290,382 - a 37.5% increase relative to November 2001.

Average daily traffic on the M5 for November 2002 was 36.2% higher than November 2001 and 3.4% higher than October 2002.

Average weekday traffic on the M5 for November 2002 was 37.4% higher than November 2001.

Average traffic on weekends and public holidays on the M5 for November 2002 was 36.5% higher than November 2001.

Non-cash transactions on the M5 in November 2002 consisted of 66% of average daily traffic (October 2002: 64%).

Average daily toll revenue (net of GST) for Statewide Roads in November 2002 was \$205,332 - a 4.1% increase relative to November 2001.

Average daily traffic on the M4 for November 2002 was 2.6% higher than November 2001 and 3.2% higher than October 2002.

Average weekday traffic on the M4 for November 2002 was 3.2% higher than November 2001.

Average traffic on weekends and public holidays on the M4 for November 2002 was 4.3% higher than November 2001.

Non-cash transactions on the M4 in November 2002 consisted of 45% of average daily traffic (October 2002: 45%).
