MACQUARIE INFRASTRUCTURE GROUP - TRADING HALT REQUEST

Macquarie Infrastructure Group (MIG) requests a trading halt for up to one trading day being Friday 22 January 2010 in accordance with Listing Rule 17.1.

The reason for the trading halt request is to enable the Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM) of MIG securityholders to be held on Friday, 22 January 2010 to consider the resolutions relating to the Restructure Proposal described in the Explanatory Memorandum issued by MIG dated 18 December 2009.

MIG expects to be able to announce the results of voting at the EGM during the afternoon of Friday, 22 January 2010.

We request the trading halt last until the results of voting have been announced.

If the necessary resolutions in respect of the Restructure Proposal are duly passed at the EGM, trading in MIG securities will be cum-Restructure Proposal for the balance of Friday, 22 January 2010 and is expected to commence on an ex-Restructure Proposal basis on Monday, 25 January 2010. Separate trading in Macquarie Atlas Roads securities is also expected to commence on a deferred settlement basis on that day under the ASX ticker code "MQA".

MIG is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted by ASX. Furthermore MIG is not aware of any other relevant information in relation to this request.
