### REVISED TOLL STRUCTURE FOR DULLES GREENWAY

**(Dulles, VA, December 01)** Toll Road Investors Partnership II, L.P. (TRIP II), the owner of the Dulles Greenway concession, announced today that as permitted by the State Corporation Commission's (SCC) approved toll structure it will increase the toll effective January 1, 2006.

#### Revised Toll Structure

- Weekday tolls at the main toll plaza, Route 606/Ox Road and Route 607/Loudoun County Parkway will increase by \$0.30 to \$2.70 for a 2 axle vehicle and by \$0.60 to \$5.40 for 3 or more axle vehicles.
- Weekend tolls at the main toll plaza, Route 606/Ox Road and Route 607/Loudoun County Parkway will increase by \$0.50 to \$2.50 for a two axle vehicle and by \$1.00 to \$5.00 for 3 or more axle vehicles.
- The new toll structure will give a discount for traveling on weekends and eliminate the discount given for travel during non-peak hours.

In addition to the change in toll amounts, the toll discounts given to those patrons using electronic toll collection will no longer be in place. It should be noted that those Greenway patrons traveling from or onto the Dulles Toll Road will continue to pay the applicable Dulles Toll Road toll (currently \$0.50 for 2 axle vehicles and \$1.00 for 3 or more axles).

The schedule of new toll rates for 2-axle vehicles is noted below:

**Background to the toll increase**

In July 2004 the SCC Commissioners ordered the following tolling schedule for 2-axle vehicles on the Dulles Greenway:

- A maximum ceiling of \$2.40, effective September 2004;
- A maximum ceiling of \$2.70 effective December 31, 2005; and
- A maximum ceiling of \$3.00 effective July 1, 2007.
