**ANNUAL REVIEW OF MOTORWAY TARIFFS ON THE  
APRR GROUP NETWORKS, AS AT 1 OCTOBER 2008**

Motorway tariffs are reviewed each year on the terms and conditions established contractually with the French State. Since 2004, this review has taken place as at 1 October each year for the APRR Group networks. For light vehicles (class 1) the average increases agreed with the State this year are 2.47% for APRR (*Autoroutes Paris-Rhin-Rhône*) and 1.64% for its subsidiary AREA (*Autoroutes Rhône-Alpes*).

**A LEVEL THAT TAKES ACCOUNT OF CONSUMER PRICE TRENDS AND OF THE  
INVESTMENT PROGRAMME**

From 1 October 2008, motorway tariffs for class 1 (light) vehicles will rise by an average of 2.47% on the APRR network and 1.64% on the AREA network. For class 4 heavy goods vehicles, the average increases will be 3.45% on the APRR network and 3.43% on the AREA network.

**TARIFF REVIEW AGREED WITH THE STATE**

Changes in motorway tariffs are regulated: the terms and conditions of rate reviews are established in the agreements signed between the concession operators and the State, currently for the period 2004 to 2008.

**OVER €1.5 BILLION OF INVESTMENT FOR MAINTENANCE AND FURTHER  
DEVELOPMENT OF THE NETWORK AND TO IMPROVE SERVICE QUALITY**

Investment programmes are established in five-year agreements that commit the concession operator out to the term of the concession. Over the period from 2004 to 2008 the Group will have invested over €1.5 billion in improving service quality, road safety, traffic flow and the comfort of millions of motorway users, notably drivers of heavy-goods vehicles, who use the Group's motorways each year.

**APRR**

Europe's fourth-largest motorway company, APRR Group, a subsidiary of Eiffage, operates a network of 2,215 km of motorway out of the 2,279 km network concession received from the State. Its motorway network includes notably the Paris-Lyon axis (A5, A6, A39), the Bourgogne - Northern Europe axis (A31 and A36), the A40, A41, A42, A43, A48, A49 and A51 North motorways in the Rhône-Alpes region and the A77 and A71 motorways in central France. The Group's motorways form a major transportation network in Europe, and in 2007 recorded more than 20 billion kilometres driven. The Group employs some 4,000 people and posted total revenues in 2007 of €1,803 million.
